Why Choose EC Virtual French?

1. Smaller Classrooms (10 students average)

- Allows for more intensive learning
- Increased time for teacher-to-student interaction
- Closer monitoring of speaking and listening
- More personalised feedback from the teacher

2. Collaborative Sessions

- Students work freely and independently with each other, reflecting real life interactions and collaboration

- In the collaborative assigned task the main interactions are among students

- Virtual classes will follow the same in-school EC curriculum

- Classes are held 2, 3 or 5 days per week to suit students' availability

How Does It Work?

1. During class (90 minutes) (180 minutes Pre-Pathways)


Small groups of 8-10 students from around the world collaborate via video call with their teacher on the lesson's objectives. They identify personal learning objectives and goals, discuss the questions and task(s), review any questions and set up the assigned task to be done after class.

2. After class: Assigned Task

(Practice, Production and Reflection)

Students are asked to work on a writing or speaking post-class collaborative activity, which they may be required to upload on Teams and share with the class. The assigned task gives students extra practice with the language learned in the lesson. This task will help identify individual strengths and identify areas that need to be developed. Follow-up discussion and feedback from their group and teacher will help students and teacher set new learning objectives.

Note: *Reflection on learning and personal goal setting create a more personalised and intensive learning experience in an online setting.*
